MINUTES OF THE KINGSTON TOWNSHIP BOARD
OF TRUSTEES MEETING
Monthly Board Meeting
July 7, 2008 7:30 p.m.

The Kingston Township Board of Trustees meeting was called to order by Chairman Akers. A moment of silence was given and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

ROLL CALL: Akers-yea; Fink-yea; Shively-absent; Talbott-yea; Stites-yea; Moore-yea

MINUTES: The minutes from the May 5, 2008 have been reviewed and accepted. A motion to accept was made by Fink with a second by Akers. Vote: Akers-yea; and Fink-yea. The Minutes of the May 28th, 2008 have been tabled. The minutes of the June 2, 2008 have been reviewed and accepted. A motion to approve the June 2nd minutes was made by Fink with a second by Akers. Vote: Akers-yea; and Fink-yea.

FINANCE: Bank Reconciliation for May 31st, 2008 was presented for approval. Motion to accept the finance report was made by Akers with a second by Fink. Vote: Akers-yea; Fink-yea.

OLD BUSINESS: Chairman Akers reported that a meeting was held with elected officials and members of the community to discuss the upcoming Identity Theft Seminar. The community meeting will be held on July 23, 2008 at the Sunbury United Methodist Church. Residents are encouraged to attend.

Chairman Akers also reported that he spoke with Rumpke (our current solid waste hauler for Kingston township) regarding curbside recycling. In order for Rumpke to offer this service, they would need 100% participation and the cost would be \$8.25 per quarter. This would bring the quarterly bill to \$46.50. More information will follow on this.

NEW BUSINESS: None to report

PORTER-KINGSTON FIRE DISTRICT COMMITTEE REPORT-AKERS

A meeting was held with FEMA .

A .25% levy is being discussed to help fund the countywide outdoor emergency warning system.

PUBLIC INPUT: A resident wanted to know if Kingston Zoning covered issues such as dirt bikes, dust, noise, etc.. The response from Chairman Akers was no. A complaint was made about resident who lives on Wilson Road at Carters Corner regarding motocross event with many dirt bikes, cars, and noise. No formal complaint was made.

Chairman Akers will talk to Prosecutor Yost about the Noise Resolution that the county adopted and refining it. Information will be brought back to the trustees for review.

ROADS UPDATE: Moore gave a report on his activity for the month of June. June 16th picked up screws in road again (early morning). Screws were found at the township maintenance building and Wilson Road /Blue Church. The Delaware County Sheriff has been notified.

CEMETERY: Shores Surveying will be contacted to find out the status of Phase II of the cemetery survey that should have been completed.

EASTERN DELAWARE COUNTY JOINT RECREATION DISTRICT-
Rich Zumpone Kingston township representative attended and reported that the board is in-active at this time

ZONING UPDATE: The deed from NorthStar to Kingston Township is still being reviewed by both parties legal counsel.

Followed-up on complaint on the property located at Rosecrans and State Route 61. A certified letter was sent to homeowner.
